



Transportation Commission Meeting Minutes
April 20th, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 3PM; the March minutes were approved as presented.

The Town Board Work Session scheduled for May 5th was discussed. Ray DiBiase of LKMA Engineering will be the lead presenter, with Vinnie Corrado of LiRo and Anthony Guardino of Farrell Fritz also presenting. Several members indicated they planned to attend. Copies of the full report and the power point will be made available after the presentation.

The members discussed the CR 39 @ Tuckahoe Rd. 'blinking signal' trial that is underway. T. Neely advised that based on 2 days of field observations, it did seem to improve the traffic flow to some degree on CR 39; how much this will impact the overall commute time is to be determined. The County is conducting multiple timing runs in order to obtain quantifiable data. This information will be compiled and analyzed after the trial is over.

The idea of creating an underpass on CR 39 near Tuckahoe Rd. was discussed; the idea of creating a new northern portion of Tuckahoe Rd. east of the existing one was also discussed; both will be considered further at the next meeting.

The roadway improvements on CR 80/Montauk Highway in Hampton Bays are nearing completion. The paving and striping should be completed within a few days. The sidewalk work and updating of the traffic signals has been completed. The traffic signal timings cannot be updated until the paving is complete and new sensors are installed in the ground; they are currently set on manual timing which has caused some issues.

The Commission members noted that there are openings on the Commission; outreach for possible new members will be discussed with the Town Board. The Commission members also expressed their interest in having greater dialogue with the Town Board and in reestablishing a direct link for input from the Land Management Department, in light of the departure of Amy Pfeiffer as liaison from Planning.

The next Commission meeting will be held on Wednesday May, 18th, 3-5PM in the Lower Level Meeting Room.
