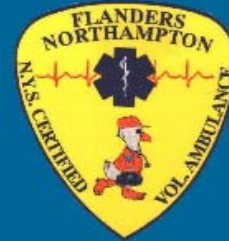

PROFESSIONAL AMBULANCE BILLING

- Currently Bills for multiple departments on Long Island including
- Huntington First Aid Squad
- Commack Community Ambulance
- Giving Flanders Ambulance funds for infrastructure such as iPads
- License to use EMS Charts for Electronic Prehospital care reports

FLANDERS AMBULANCE PLAN

- ❖ 4 Year Pilot program (trial)
- ❖ 1st year getting licenses, Medicare billing etc.
- ❖ 2nd year getting bugs worked out of the system
- ❖ 3rd and 4th year getting a good idea of revenue
- ❖ During the pilot program have meetings to keep public up to date on progress
- ❖ After pilot program. Public vote!

REVENUE

- 1,200 calls a year .
- If 900 calls are billed
- 900 calls x \$600.00 insurance bill
- \$540,000 !

PUBLIC CONCERNS

- Patient not having insurance
- "Cant get blood out of a stone"
- Hardship forms are provided if you cannot pay
- District can wave bill.
