The caretaker's cottage, as well as the stable, the 2-car garage and the greenhouse plus large vegetable gardens were located on the east side of the estate drive, approximately half way between the entrance gate and the manor house.



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The massive *modern picturesque* style garage, or 'carriage house,' originally spanned the driveway with a 6-car garage on the east side and a 3-bedroom apartment on the west.



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The formal entrance to the manor house was through an archway in the center of the carriage house and down the hill. A service drive passed to the east of the carriage house and provided access to the service entrance to the manor house.
