

DESCRIPTION

This proposal is the first phase to conduct a site characterization assessment in order to place a Nitrogen Removing Biofilter (NRB), developed by the NYS Center for Clean Water Technology, to tie in with the existing sanitary systems at the Westhampton Beach High School and Middle School for increased nitrogen removal (effluent reduced to less than 5 mg/L and from 1800 lbs per year to 90 lbs/year)
