Allow Certain 4x4 Permit Holders to Use Lake Agawam Parking Lot as Mitigation for Beach Driving Closures due to Piping Plover and Least Tern Activity on the Ocean Beach

WHEREAS the Trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the Town of Southampton (the "Trustees") are the owners of a parking lot that borders the southerly shore of Lake Agawam located in the Incorporated Village of Southampton, known as the Lake Agawam Parking Lot; and

WHEREAS, the breeding activity of Piping Plovers and Least Terns, which are either endangered or threatened species that are protected by the federal Endangered Species Act and the Laws of the State of New York, has required the Trustees to close 4x4 beach driving throughout the Town of Southampton, and

WHEREAS, the Trustees have heard the numerous requests from the freeholders and residents of the Town to find ways to mitigate the reduced access to the beach caused by the 4x4 beach driving closures; and now therefore be it

RESOLVED, vehicles bearing a valid 2019 Trustees 4x4 permit and a 2019 Southampton Village 4x4 driving permit shall be permitted to park in the Lake Agawam Parking located in the Incorporated Village of Southampton. Any car using the Lake Agawam Parking lot pursuant to this resolution must have BOTH of the aforementioned permits; and be it further

RESOLVED, this resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be repealed by the Trustees, once the full picnic area re-opens in 2019.
