The Town Board will be voting on Resolution 2015-733 for “*Final Scope for the Preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Zone Change Application Entitled "The Hills at Southampton", to Rezone Certain Properties in the Hamlet of East Quogue from Residential 200 (CR200) to Mixed-Use Planned Development District (MUPDD)*” at July 14th town board meeting. Copies of the amended draft will be made available to us.

Stephen Jones spoke with us regarding excessive noise from leafblowers, and supplied us with a handout referencing the issue and some proposed solutions.
