OLD BUSINESS

- The turning lane has been painted on Bay Avenue at the corner of Foster Xing. We thank Alex Gregor and Brad Bender for their attention in addressing this issue.
- The obstructive hedge at the corner of Halsey and Montauk is still in place. The owner of the property has been cited with an appearance ticket, but there is no update as of yet.
- The old #14 telephone pole on Lewis Road has still not been removed.
- The “plastic bag ban” will be the subject of a work session on November 20th at noon, and a public hearing at the November 25th Town Board meeting at 6pm.

NEW BUSINESS

- We discussed the possibility of commercial use of a parcel of land on Montauk Highway, currently owned by the Parlatos.
- We will be providing the Town Board with our names and term dates for reappointment to CAC in 2015.
- There is a suggestion of adding a traffic mirror at the corner of Spinney Road and Lewis Road, and there was a question on the procedure to obtain one.
- The East Quogue tree lighting will take place on Saturday December 6th at 5pm on the Village Green. The Methodist Church is also holding their Holly Tea from 10am -4pm, and the East Quogue Historical Society will open the museum at Asbury House during some of that time.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30pm. Next meeting to be held on Wednesday December 10th in the East Quogue School Library.
