Help keep the North Sea Skate Park safe as we navigate through COVID-19 by following all rules and procedures.

- Do not enter the playground area or use the equipment if you or any member of your household is currently experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- This facility is use at your own risk. Equipment may not be sanitized on an on-going basis.
- No more than 10 people in the skate park at a time.
- Face Coverings are Required
- Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or use hand sanitizer, prior to entering and after leaving the skate park.
- Stay at least 6 feet away from others.
- All skaters must follow rules and directions from staff, or they will be asked to leave.

No skating or trespassing is permitted when the Park is closed. Violators will be prosecuted.

Recklessness will not be tolerated. All skaters must use the Park responsibly to avoid injury to themselves or others. The use of proper skater etiquette is expected at all times.

- Profanity, abusive language, and/or fighting are not tolerated.
- Smoking is prohibited within the Park.
- Shoes required at all times.
- Use of drugs, alcohol, and/or vandalism is prohibited on Town property.
- The following are not allowed in the Park: food, beverages, gum, and loose items, such as backpacks, coats, and radios/boom boxes. Glass containers are prohibited on Town property.
- Report visible hazards and/or repair needs to the Parks Department 631-728-8585.
- The Town is not responsible for personal property.

Violation of these rules may result in ejection from the Skate Park.
