




SOILS SUITABILITY

- Good for Agriculture and Homesites
 - Good for Agriculture but Unsuitable for Homesites because of Flooding
 - Offering Problems for Agriculture and Homesites because of Slopes
 - Unsuitable for Agriculture and Homesites because of Slopes and Poor Texture

- Agricultural Development Plan**
- Good Agricultural Soils Preserved due to Planned Residential Development
 - Problem Soils to Receive Special Slope Treatment
 - Sod Waterways to be Established
- Planned Residential Development Plan**
- Detached Dwelling Units, One and Two-Family
 - Townhouses On-The-Green
