My war work ~~xxxxxxxx~~ included five months confidential work with the Col. House Commission to gather data for the eventual Peace Conference under the Dept. of State. Against the wishes of the Dept. I volunteered for the Army (Chemical warfare) and was asked to do special work in the Intelligence. There I wrote among other things, the military handbook for the field used by the American, British and French forces in the North Russian campaign. I saw no active fighting. When the Peace Conference came I was assigned to special duty there again with the Col. House body of specialists and served for some months until my return to The U.S. and received my discharge. I have letters from the Col. House Commission and from the Peace Conference, commending my work.
