*Landed at Brest July 13, '18 where we did trucking from docks to  
warehouses for about two months. We then went to the front near  
Amiens and landed supplies for the 27<sup>th</sup> Division. Left Corbie the  
day after Thanksgiving '18 for Le Mans by truck. Sailed from Brest about  
Mar 6, '19. I had passed all examinations and was to attend  
the officers training school for the Engineer Corps Nov 7, '18. This  
order was recalled on account of the Committee.*
