Arvid Gulline was his young 4th into the army while July 1918 - served with the Field Artillery at base N. O. F. C. - was in ¹⁹¹⁵⁻¹⁶⁻¹⁷ Plattsburgh Camp - 1916. While stationed in Camp 1914 - had expected 4th to France Dec 1st 1918. Armistice being declared he returned to college
