Enlisted on May 21, 1918 but was not sent to U.S.M.C. Training camp until June 21. Took my military training there and upon completion was inducted into the Marine Barracks ^{Band} at Norfolk, Va. where I played the clarinet in their band. My application for U.S.M.C. Aviation was in for my date of enlistment and sufficient red tape was consumed so that I received the rating of Gunnery Sgt. which was the marine rating for Cadet or beginner in ground school of aviation. Thus on Oct. 22 I was transferred to aviation - sent to Philadelphia Pa. for initial training and was so located when the certificate I was called. We were then placed back at our former rating and I was sent to Fort Mifflin, Pa. on ground duty. From the Marine Barracks there I received my honorable discharge.
