Remarks Was inducted into service at Camp Upton May 29/18 sent to Camp Gravelly, Ga. June 16, sent to Camp Crane Allen Town Pa. Aug 1/18 Left for Overseas from N.Y. Aug. 24/18 and landed at Liverpool Eng. Sept 5/18 crossed Eng channel to Havre France about Sept 16/18 Went from Havre to a small village by the name of Thesse in the center part of France. from there to Paris, and then on to Staden Belgium. It was at Staden where we received the wounded to be operated on, receiving them from the lines most of the boys coming during the night hours and quite badly hurt. Staying our ten days at Staden four of the boys died and were buried in their blankets.
