ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED BY WETLANDS PERMIT NO. CB1300086: On March 3, 2015, Wetlands Permit No. CB1300086 was issued in order to grant approval to demolish and remove an existing hurricane damaged single family dwelling, inclusive of the masonry foundation, as well as the southwest patio and steps, with an existing house footprint of 835.5 square feet, and a patio and steps footprint of approximately 144 square feet, and with a current first floor elevation of 7.7 feet, located 39 feet from wetlands; to abandon an existing septic system, by pumping the system clean and by backfilling the system with clean sand and/or by removing the system, in accordance with Suffolk County Department of Health Services (SCDHS) requirements, located, at its closest point, approximately 18 feet from wetlands; to construct a new two story four bedroom single family dwelling, on pilings, with a footprint of 20 feet x 50 feet (1000 square feet), in compliance with FEMA requirements, with a planned first floor elevation of 11.0 feet, located, within the same location as the existing dwelling, at its closest point, approximately 37.9 feet from wetlands; to construct approximately 300 square feet of elevated deck on pilings, within the partial footprint of 546 square feet of former attached deck, which historically existed at the site, located approximately 35.7 feet from wetlands; to replace an existing canvas over frame wood platform storage structure, with a 12 foot x 16 foot (192 square feet) frame shed located 19.6 feet from wetlands; to install a new upgraded septic system, in order to service both the main and secondary dwellings, including one (1) 2000 gallon septic tank and (12) 8 foot diameter x 2 foot deep leaching pools with room for 50% future expansion, in accordance with SCDHS requirements, with the future expansion pools located, at their closest point, 36.8 feet from wetlands; to repair and heighten the existing masonry foundation for a secondary hurricane damaged one story house, having a footprint of approximately 564 square feet, in order to raise the first floor elevation from 7 feet to 11.0 feet, in order to meet current FEMA requirements, located approximately 56 feet from wetlands; to repair approximately 116 square feet of wood deck and steps, at the southwest corner of the secondary one story dwelling located approximately 50 feet from wetlands; to construct approximately 128 square feet of deck addition, at the southeast corner of the secondary one story dwelling located approximately 49 feet from wetlands; to construct/improve an existing driveway, along the east side of the secondary one story dwelling located approximately 62 feet from wetlands; to deposit approximately 353 cubic yards of clean sand fill, in order to elevate the new septic system, located approximately 16 feet from wetlands; to construct concrete retaining walls, in order to partially contain the fill for the new elevated septic system; and to undertake other repairs, renovations and customary floodproofing improvements, as necessary, at existing residentially developed property, fronting Reeves Bay, which gains access off a private road and which contains state and town regulated naturally vegetated tidal wetlands in Flanders, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, in accordance with the survey prepared by Nathan Taft Corwith dated September 17, 2007, last revised May 12, 2014.

ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED BY THE PERMIT MODIFICATION: Wetland Permit No. CB1300086 was modified on March 14, 2018 in order to allow for installation of a new Innovative/Alternative On-Site Wastewater Treatment System (I/A OWTS), consisting of one (1) 1,000 gallon septic tank, one (1) 800 gallon recirculation tank and three (3) 4 ft. wide x 22 ft. long dispersion trenches, with room for future 50% expansion, located, at its closest point, 33 feet from wetlands; construction of approximately 104 linear feet of dry stack retaining wall, in order to contain fill associated with elevation of the I/A OTWS, located 13 feet from wetlands; and deposition of approximately 150 cubic yards of clean compatible sand fill, in order to elevate the I/A OWTS, located approximately

16 feet from wetlands; in accordance with a survey prepared by Nathan Taft Corwin III, dated September 17, 2007, last revised February 28, 2018 and the “ 19 Netz Place Town of Southampton Septic Site Plan” prepared by David Wayne Rhodes, date January 15, 2018, last revised February 3, 2018.

WETLANDS PERMIT NO. CB1300086 was renewed by the issuance of Administrative Wetland Permit Nos. WAR1600060 and WAR170068 and will expire on August 14, 2018.
