Description of Permitted Activity: To demolish and remove an existing unauthorized re-configured/ expanded residential stone driveway with tar aggregate base, followed by reconstruction in-place of an environmentally compatible pervious stone driveway, without asphalt/tar aggregate mix subbase or other impervious or potentially toxic subbase or asphalt coating, proximate to Far Pond, as well as landward of the Shinnecock Bay and an arm of Middle Pond, known as Honey Pot Pond; to legalize the construction of a stone block drive apron proximate to Far Pond; and to excavate and remove or abandon by concrete plugging an existing unauthorized PVC pipe, to the east of an existing two story house, adjacent to Middle Pond, at existing residentially developed property, fronting town regulated tidal wetlands, in Shinnecock Hills, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, **in accordance with a survey prepared by Lester Holden, dated August 10, 2010, last revised March 5, 2020.**
