Description of Permitted Activity: To restore and re-vegetate the disturbed portions of an existing required covenanted wetlands non-disturbance/non-fertilization buffer, which is currently being maintained as mowed lawn, by demolishing an existing circular masonry brick foundation, inclusive of fence atop, located approximately 50 feet landward of wetlands, by relocating any existing wire fence, remaining within the buffer, to the landward boundary of the existing covenanted wetlands buffer, by removing the existing lawn, and by installing town approved native plants, while allowing for retention of the existing flag pole and establishment of a maximum four feet wide pervious pedestrian path to the existing dock, at residentially developed property, having frontage on Fish Creek, and containing town and state regulated tidal wetlands, in Remsenburg/Speonk, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, **in accordance with the survey prepared by David H. Fox, dated May 4, 2021, last revised August 23, 2021, and the “Carol S. Wolfe & Lawrence B. Wolfe Revegetation Plan” prepared by Dragonfly Landscape Design, dated April 13, 2021, last revised May 29, 2021.**
