Description of Permitted Activity: To undertake shoreline stabilization measures authorized pursuant to Administrative Wetlands Permit No. WAP20055, including deposition of sand, cobble and stone, as well as installation of native vegetation, along the shoreline of Little Peconic Bay; to institute additional wetland protection measures, including establishment of a covenanted wetland preservation zones and naturally vegetated wetland non-disturbance non-fertilization buffers; to complete construction and installation of a relocated open grate light penetrable decked stairway for access to the bay beach; and to establish a maximum 4 feet wide previous pedestrian path to access the new stairway; with the authorized activities strictly conditioned upon supplemental reclamation and restoration of the upper bay beach and bank/bluff; confinement of future pedestrian access to the one authorized relocated stairway; and upon removal of temporary haybale barriers, along the bank/bluff toe and upper bay beach, by June 1, 2022, at existing residentially developed property fronting the Little Peconic Bay and containing town and state regulated tidal wetlands, in North Sea, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, in accordance with the survey prepared by Robert A. Smith, dated April 11, 2013, last revised September 13, 2021 "*Proposed Stone, Sand and Planting for Robert Crabb, 9 East Shore Road, Little Peconic Bay, Town of Southampton, Suffolk Co., NY*", drawing as prepared by En-Consultants, dated July 29, 2020.
