Description of Permitted Activity: To abandon existing sanitary structures, inclusive of an 8 foot diameter x 6 foot deep sanitary cesspool, located 137.7 feet from average high water and the nearest Town regulated wetlands, and an 8 foot diameter by 8 foot deep cesspool located 107.2 feet from average high water and wetlands, by pumping the cesspools clean and backfilling the cesspools with clean sand and/or by removing the cesspools, in accordance with Suffolk County Dept. of Health Services (SCDHS) requirements; to construct a new upgraded compliant sanitary system, including one (1) 1500 gallon septic tank and two (2) 8 foot diameter x 8 feet deep leaching pools with room for 50% future expansion, in accordance with SCDHS requirements, located, at their closest point, 152.8 feet from wetlands; to remove approximately 102.2 cubic yards of soil, as part of the sanitary system upgrades; to deposit approximately 61.4 cubic yards of clean sand, in order to elevate the sanitary system located approx 150 feet landward of wetlands; to temporarily remove and relocate an existing shed, in order to allow for construction of the new septic system and water service improvements; to abandon an existing well located greater than 150 feet from wetlands; and to install a water service line, in order to connect the existing house to the street water main, located greater than 125 feet landward of wetlands, at existing residentially developed property, fronting Mill Creek and Town regulated tidal wetlands, where average high water extends landward of the shorefront bulkhead, on the adjacent road end, within Noyac, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, in accordance with the "*Shargel Residence-Sanitary System Improvements Project*" site plan, as prepared by Vincent Gaudiello of the Raynor Group, P.E., & L.S. PLLC dated November 21, 2013.

Description of Permitted Activity: To restore shorelands and wetland adjacent area, alongside Fresh Pond, and south of a private right-of-way, known as East Shore Road, that were adversely impacted, by clearing, grading, soil deposition, and lawn establishment, by removal of existing lawn, by restoring pre-existing natural grades and soil conditions, and by re-vegetating lands within 15 feet of the existing deteriorated bulkhead, with *Spartina patens* plugs six (6) inches on center, and lands extending from 15 feet landward of the bulkhead to the road, with beach grass (*Ammophila breviligulata*) and switch grass (*Panicum virgatum*) plugs 12 inches on center, at existing residentially developed property fronting Fresh Pond, and the Little Peconic Bay, which are regulated as tidal wetlands, in North Sea, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York.
