HELPFUL TIPS TO PREVENTION

CAR BREAK-INS

Year round, the Southampton Town Police Department receives numerous reports of vehicle break-ins and thefts. Below are a few tips to think about while you are away from your car to deter potential thieves.







- CHOOSE A GOOD PARKING SPACE: At your home consider a well-lit driveway or parking inside of
 a garage. If you are going to be shopping in the evening, park in a well-lit and open parking area.
- LEAVE YOUR PURSE/BACKPACK OR VALUABLES OUT OF SIGHT: If possible, keep your
 goodies in the trunk instead of in the viewable passenger area. If a thief sees items that may be valuable, they
 are more likely to target your car. If they see nothing, they will likely move on to another.
- USE A VEHICLE WITH AN ALARM SYSTEM, IF POSSIBLE: Thieves are less likely to break into a car
 with a blinking alarm light. Double check to make sure the alarm is activated.
- TAKE ELECTRONICS WITH YOU: Either put the portable devices in a hidden place, out of view, or take it with you. Those are items that attract thieves, because they are easy to grab, carry, and sell.
- LOCK YOUR DOORS: This should be a "no-brainer" but we take quite a few police reports where car doors
 were left unlocked. Some thieves will actually walk around a parking lot checking car doors for an easy target.
