Meeting minutes

STAR- Southampton Town Aquatic center met with Southampton Village at Downs Park. They hired Tim Rumph to look at various sites. STAR looked at Moses Park, Stony Brook Southampton Hospital at Southampton College, Red Creek Hampton Bays (need more land 1.5 acres for parking, 344 Magee St. 5.8 acres, and Downs Park.

Town board approved amending CPF law for pool (Parks and Recreation). Josephine gave a short history and update for pool. We opened the meeting up for questions, main concerns were traffic issues and objections of CPF money for buildout.

Tommy John - Southampton Aircraft Advisory committee reports that in 2021 East Hampton Town will be able to make changes in operation. Airplane noise complaint form on East Hampton Town website. Complaints to East Hampton Town Board increased overall 33%.

North Sea Beach Plan- Concerns of driving on beach, we want enforcement 1st, then other steps taken versus putting up boulders on beach.

Mark Matthews gave a report on erosion control plan.

Planning Board results - Stachecki property- ZBA approved C of O. October 22 work session, November 2nd Public Hearing.

Solid Waste Committee- Recyclables are costing money to dispose of. People are just recycling at the transfer stations and not using green bags to offset recycling costs and using private carters for trash. Talk right now of \$50.00 a year recycling fee.

Tupper Boathouse- Mark Matthews reports successful bid of lifting house and stabilizing. Ann Reisman made good comments on house.

There was a question raised on changing zoning of Strong's marina, Julie will check.

Dario's Landscaping- A comment was made about employees parking on North Sea Road.
