1. Who is Eligible – Town of Southampton Residents age 60 and over, who are homeowners or renters
2. THE RESIDENTIAL REPAIR PROGRAM PROVIDES HOUSEHOLD ASSISTANCE WITH CHORES THAT DO NOT REQUIRED THE SKILLS OF A LICENSED CRAFTSMAN. THIS IS NOT AN EMERGENCY SERVICE.
3. The Residential Repair Program Provides:
  - a. Replacing faucet washers or faucets, and other minor plumbing repairs such as clearing clogged drains.
  - b. Installing new ball cocks and flapper when needed.
  - c. Replacing fuse, door locks, window catches and windowpanes.
  - d. Installing handrails and safety rails for tubs and toilets. **minor repairs – No Major Construction**
  - e. Installing and removing air conditioners
  - f. Installation and removal of screens/storm windows
  - g. Repair of screens
  - h. Caulking windows and installing weather stripping around doors
  - i. Installing shades and curtain rods, tacking down rugs
  - j. Minor repairs of the exterior of the home
  - k. Installing smoke alarms/CO detectors and changing batteries
  - l. Cleaning gutters (one story high only)
