The Town of Southampton has established a food scrap drop-off site as part of our commitment to divert waste from incinerators and landfills, and to improve local soil.

By diverting food waste from your green bags, you reduce odors in your garbage can and make more room for waste. The more you recycle and compost, the fewer green bags you will use!

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fruits & vegetables (remove labels, bands, ties etc.) • Bread, pasta, rice, grains • Eggshells • Coffee grounds, loose tea • Chips, snacks, candy nuts & seeds • Cut flowers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastics & styrofoam • Fats, oils, grease • Meat, fish, poultry, bones • Milk, yogurt, cheese, dairy products • Compostable plastics, packaging, yard debris • Diapers, baby/hand wipes • Pet waste, cat litter
